The Boeing Classic is an Official Event on the PGA TOUR Champions, which features the legends of golf 50 years of age or older. Jerry Kelly is the tournament's defending Champion after a victory at the 13th event, which also featured 87,000 spectators and was supported by approximately 1,000 volunteers during Tournament Week. Over the past decade more than \$6 million has been raised for the Benaroya Research Institute at Virginia Mason, the Heart Institute at Virginia Mason Medical Center, and additional Greater Seattle Charities.
