Things to Know

- Defending champion **Stephen Ames** overcame a seven-stroke final-round deficit to win the Boeing Classic for the second consecutive year.

Stephen Ames, 71-67-67 – 205 (-11)

- The 60-year-old earned his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions (214 starts)
- This is his seventh win in his last 39 starts after winning two times in his first 175 starts on PGA TOUR Champions
- Earned his third win of the 2024 season (17 starts)
 - Previous wins in 2024: Chubb Classic (Feb. 16-18); Mitsubishi Electric Classic (April 26-28)
 - Remains No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Matched Ernie Els (3) for the most wins by any player in the 2024 season on PGA TOUR Champions
- Earned his second win at the Boeing Classic, defending his title from 2023
 - Becomes the third multi-time winner of the Boeing Classic, joining Tom Kite (2006, 2008) and Bernhard Langer (2010, 2016)
- Matched the largest final-round comeback in the 19-year history of the Boeing Classic (7)
 - Previous instance: Brandt Jobe (2019)
- Matched the fourth-largest final-round comeback in PGA TOUR Champions history
 - The last comeback of seven or more strokes entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions was Stephen Ames (2021 Principal Charity Classic)
- This is the third successful title defense of the 2024 season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Previous instances: Stephen Ames (Mitsubishi Electric Classic); Padraig Harrington (DICK'S Open)

Other Notes

- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els** finished T2 at 10-under after closing with 68. He remains atop the Charles Schwab Cup standings after earning his sixth top-3 finish of the season (14 starts).

- **Steven Alker** shot bogey-free 68 to finish T2 at 10-under. He remains No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after earning his fifth top-2 finish of the season (13 starts). This is Alker's 22nd top-2 finish on PGA TOUR Champions (66 starts), an average of 33% of his starts.
- After playing the first 38 holes without a bogey, overnight leader **Robert Karlsson** closed with 3-over 75 to finish T2 at 10-under. He matched his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions, taking runner-up honors for the sixth time (82 starts).
- **Charlie Wi** and **Kirk Triplett**, each of whom played in the final group, finished T5 at 8-under.
- Two-time champion (2010, 2016) **Bernhard Langer** holed out for eagle on the 18th hole to finish T8 at 6-under. It was his record-extending 227th top-10 finish on PGA TOUR Champions (349 starts).
- **John Senden** (T13) carded the low round of the day with 7-under 65.
- In his first PGA TOUR Champions start since March, Seattle native **Fred Couples** finished T18 at 4-under.
- **Steve Jones** withdrew during the final round.
